Please bring your 6 t-shirts, cutter, a 6”x 24” ruler and a 16”x16” ruler (if you have one!). We can share ours if you don’t have one. This class will focus on how to stabilize the shirts, squaring them up and putting them together with simple sashing. We will have red, blue or black sashing available to use. We will be making a 6 shirt sample. Class size is limited, so please reserve your spot as soon as possible. If you have been considering giving a T-Shirt quilt as a graduation gift (either having us create it from scratch or just quilting it for you), please come see us as soon as possible so we can be assured it is completed in time!
